Dear Bathurst Quay Resident,

As you may already know, a shooting took place in our community shortly before midnight on August 17th. While the incident is still under police investigation, I can confirm that two individuals were injured.

Incidents like this can be quite traumatic for our community. At City Hall we have now initiated the Community Crisis Response Program (CCRP) to provide immediate and ongoing support for the neighbourhood. CCRP staff are in the neighbourhood today connecting with impacted residents and ensuring that resources and supports are available. In the coming days and weeks we will be working closely with the neighbourhood and City departments to coordinate next steps.

Our Bathurst Quay neighbourhood is an exceptionally strong one. More than 2,700 people live here. We have condos, co-ops, and TCHC buildings. We have a community centre, school, the waterfront, and beautiful parks. Our neighbourhood is diverse and strong. Together, let's keep it that way.
